The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to all Diplomatic Missions, Consular Representatives and International Organisations (DCIOs) in Thailand and, further to the Ministry's Note No. 0404/c.1417 dated 31 July B.E. 2563 (2020) regarding the extension of temporary stay in the Kingdom for stranded foreign nationals, has the honour to seek DCIOs' cooperation to advise the foreign nationals as follows:

1. Pursuant to the Notification of the Ministry of Interior on Permission for Certain Groups of Aliens to Remain in the Kingdom as a Special Case (No. 4) issued on 30 September B.E. 2563 (2020), the period of time permitted for temporary stay in the Kingdom under the said Notification will end on 31 October 2020. Any foreign nationals who wish to stay in the Kingdom beyond that date must submit an application for extension of temporary stay at the Immigration Bureau within 31 October 2020.

2. Late application for extension of temporary stay can be submitted within 90 days after 31 October 2020, subject to a fine. After the end of such period, those who remain in the Kingdom or have not applied for extension of temporary stay shall be deemed as overstaying. They will subsequently be prosecuted, deported and prohibited from entering the Kingdom.

3. In this connection, the Ministry wishes to seek the DCIOs' kind cooperation to inform their citizens about the said Notification.
